Regional Snapshot provides easy access to a wide range of subnational products via the National Statistics website. The snapshot was introduced to improve access to and presentation of regional and subregional information. It offers additional/alternative presentations and interpretations for various levels of geography which complement more in-depth analysis available in flagship publications such as Regional Trends. It provides more up-to-date data between editions of Regional Trends, replacing the Region in Figures series, covering a selection of information at regional and local authority levels of geography.

This webpage acts as a route map to a wide range of products - publications, reports, datasets, mapping and graphical representations. Regional Snapshot currently provides for each region or country of the UK:

- an overview for each area
- table of key regional statistics
- map showing population densities for constituent local authorities
- a selection of statistics at unitary/local authority and district level
- links to further regional information.

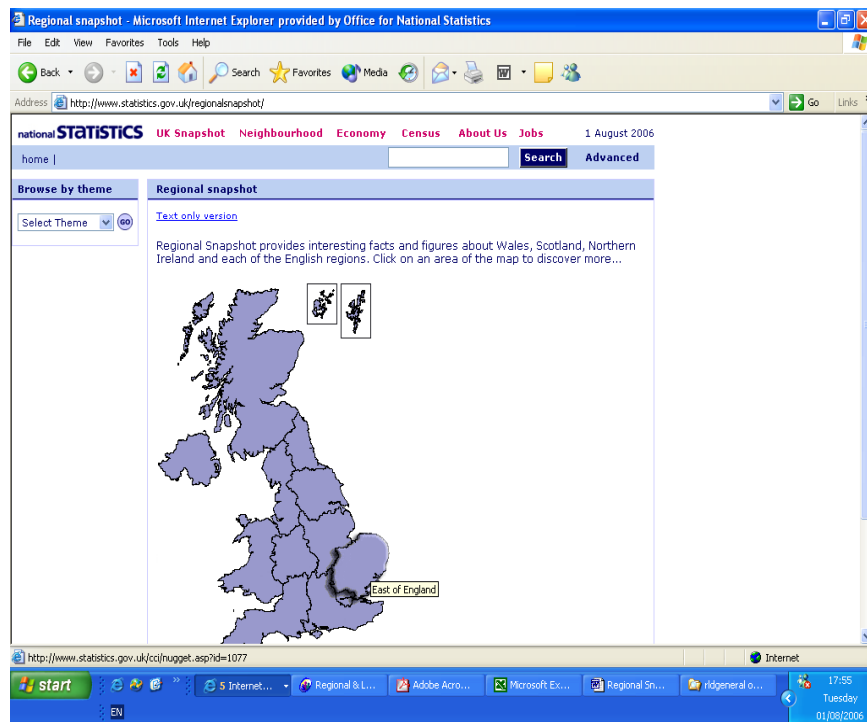
The subject-based section now includes 72 different tables, some for more than one time period, of which 18 provide sub-regional data. The latest release in December 2007 updates some of the tables previously released on Regional Snapshot in the areas of Population and Migration, Crime, Education, Housing, Benefits.
