Regional Skills, Employment and Enterprise Analysis 2009

Introduction

SLIM is in the process of developing a specification for the development of the Regional Skills, Employment and Enterprise Analysis 2009 (aka the Gap Analysis). This is intended to provide the evidence base for the refresh of the ESF Frameworks and the RESP priorities. Although the timing of the Single Regional Strategy is unknown, the analysis may also feed into the development of the Skills element of the strategy.

Evidence requirements

Set out in the attached table are some of the key evidence sources used in the 2007 Analysis. The 2007 Analysis built closely upon the work of the partners and drew heavily for instance on the LSC strategic analysis.

The performance monitoring group is asked, at the meeting, to review:

- a) The evidence sources that need to be incorporated into the Gap Analysis, as well as the timing and availability of these from partners;
- b) The broad approach;
- c) Any key additional issues/questions that partners might want to see addressed.
